The objectives of the Redlands Coast Business Excellence Awards Program for 2021 and beyond are to:

- Recognise business excellence in line with the Redlands Coast Chamber of Commerce strategic vision and plan
- Celebrate the growth, improvement and innovation of local business and industry
- Promote excellence in business leadership, strategy and relationships to deliver results
- **Support** and celebrate a culture of community spirit and connection.

Award criteria and interview questions are aligned with the Awards Framework and Objectives to allow businesses across all sectors and industries to tell their story in a way that allows for consistent, fair and measurable merit-based judging.

## **AWARD CRITERIA AND GUIDANCE**

Applicants can nominate themselves into only ONE Category (please find the category that is a "best fit" for your industry).

\*This does not apply to applicants wishing to enter People's Choice or Women in Business categories.

These categories may be entered into as additional categories.

Applicants should frame their responses on the last 12-14 months of business activity.

Four award questions are judged to give a total score out of 100 points. Total scores will be used to determine the finalists and winners.

Responses can be submitted through:

- Written Response (recommended max 500 words per question)
- Video Response (recommended max. 2 minutes per question)

Additional collateral can be included with your submission. Suitable collateral includes:

- Photos (please be mindful of image size)
- Videos (please be mindful of file size)
- Testimonials (recommended max. 100 words)
- Website information
- Socials information
